If your **Life Purpose** is symbolized by Archetype Number **5**: You are a **Freedom Lover and Catalyst for Change**

Archetype Number **5** symbolizes our capacity to overcome limitations and oppression, to let go of anything that is no longer serving us, to innovate, and to experience freedom in areas where we (or the systems we participate in) have been limited. The Number 5 path of development empowers us to advocate for change, to spread our wings, and to participate in life as a grand adventure!



The Five Pointed Star, or pentagram, is a symbol of Archetype Number 5 and is one of the most potent, powerful, and persistent symbols in human history. This particular symbolism has persisted for centuries, and has greatly influenced theologies of diverse traditions. It has been important to almost every ancient culture, from the Mayans of Latin America, to cultures in India, China, Greece, and Egypt. In many traditions, the pentagram can symbolize the unity of mankind with the earth, the human body, and the realm of the spirit.

For the Archetype Number 5, when you are centered and aligned, you:

- Love new experiences and want to try everything
- Are always drawn to the leading edge
- Like to go off the beaten path and find new ways to get there
- Are willing to go out beyond your comfort zone
- Enjoy stirring the pot in service of something better
- Love to transform systems that have become limitations
- Are a Change Agent
- Value self-development
- Love to witness others grow and change
- Are vibrantly alive in your body
- Breathe fresh air into the room because you are open to innovation
- Are the spirit of new possibilities
- Attract others by your excitement for life
- Can easily and playfully promote anything you believe in
- Are most happy in relationships that understand and support your freedom

When stressed, triggered, or in need of healing or change, you may:

- Limit yourself, and your freedom, unnecessarily
- Be too afraid to let your wings unfurl and take a chance
- Not understand how to use freedom, possibly losing your freedom of choice
- Move too quickly and not let things take root
- Be self-indulgent in a way that can impact others negatively
- Not allow yourself to experience the pleasure that you are capable of



- Resist anything that you fear may take away your freedom
- Want to stay in the safety of the known
- Be reckless
- Not understand that freedom can increase with acceptance of certain limitations
- Resent restriction and responsibility
- Have a tendency toward addiction
- Not understand how to be free and committed at the same time
- Resist making and maintaining habits and routines that would make your life easier
- Be rigid in your thinking
- Lack vitality

"Gloria Marie Steinem (born March 25, 1934) is an American feminist, journalist, and social and political activist who became nationally recognized as a leader and spokeswoman for the feminist movement in the late 1960s and early 70s. She was a columnist for New York Magazine and a founder of Ms. magazine. In 1969, she published an article, "After Black Power, Women's Liberation," which brought her to national fame as a feminist leader. Ms. Steinem has received dozens of awards, and in 2015 published her memoirs, "My Life On the Road". She remains an

active voice for women's rights even today. On November 22, 2013, Gloria Steinem was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Barack Obama."
